## **Camp rules**



The rules are simple and the same for every AFS participant.

- You must follow all international AFS rules you have signed at the beginning of the program.
- No parties at night. You are not allowed to stay late at night, as night is the time to sleep. Take a rest after a busy day, as the next day will also be full of different activities.
- Alcohol is strictly forbidden during the trip. Violation of this rule will be followed by Early Return to the Sending Country immediately.
- **Keep safe**. You are responsible for yourself first of all. Follow all volunteer instructions.
- **Be punctual**, otherwise you can miss the most interesting events.
- Ask if you don't know anything or have a problem.
- **Be tidy**. Don't make a mess in your room. Don't damage any hotel facilities. You will have to reimburse the expense.

- your passport/migration card/registration (original docs !!!)
- Pocket money. Cash in rubles; you won't have time to change. See details about expenses in **Optional activity form (the page above)**.

#### Remember! You are responsible for your documents and money.
